



# Digital Passenger Declaration (DPD) QR code

## About the DPD

The Digital Passenger Declaration (DPD) captures information from passengers seeking to enter Australia. Information provided in a DPD assists the Australian Government to manage health and safety measures.

Before travelling to Australia, all passengers arriving by air should submit a DPD, unless they are a flight crew member.

Parents / guardians should complete a declaration for any child under 16 years of age. Anyone who is 16 years old or over should complete their own declaration.

## Completing the DPD

To complete the DPD, passengers will need:

- flight number
- a valid passport
- COVID-19 vaccination record or proof you cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons
- a valid, negative COVID-19 test result
- destination and quarantine arrangements (if required)
- travel history for the 14 days prior to departure

If you have multiple flights, you can list your first flight and the flight that lands in Australia on your declaration.

**Passengers need to show their completed DPD summary screen to airline staff at check-in and on arrival in Australia.**
